## Minnesota Celebrates Homeownership Month with Free Homebuyer Education Opportunities

In celebration of Homeownership month in June, Minnesota Housing, the Minnesota Association of Realtors®, USDA Rural Development and the Minnesota Homeownership Center announced the availability of free homebuyer education. In Minnesota, homebuyer education is available online and inperson. Both courses include an in-depth understanding of the homebuying process, how to choose the right home, the importance of credit and good financial management, how a lender determines how much to lend, the importance of working with a real estate professional and the buyer's rights and responsibilities once they become an owner.

Minnesota Housing worked with the Homeownership Center to organize a press conference to announce the free workshops and coupons for the online Framework courses and developed a social media campaign to help drive traffic to the our websites for more information. Free in-person Home Stretch Workshops were available at participating locations throughout the state from June 22-29. Interested homebuyers were able to find a workshop near them by looking at a comprehensive list of homebuyer educators on the Minnesota Homeownership Center website at <a href="www.hocmn.org">www.hocmn.org</a> or participate in a new online homebuyer education option called Framework (<a href="www.frameworkhomeownership.org">www.frameworkhomeownership.org</a>). Framework is the most comprehensive online homebuyer education course available, and we provided free coupons for the first 100 people who sign up. Framework was designed by industry leaders in online education and has been thoroughly tested by first-time homebuyers. The program meets the National Industry Standards and all the requirements of the HUD Housing Counseling program.

Since Framework is a new tool, this event provided the opportunity to showcase it to a broader audience that may not have been aware of this online education option. Working with the Homeownership Center, we reached out to lenders and real estate professionals who are experienced with our programs and understand the importance of homebuyer education and provided additional coupons beyond the 100 announced at the press conference. Minnesota currently has the largest homeownership gap between white households and households of color, so we also identified real estate professionals who work with emerging market communities and provided additional coupons for them to share with prospective buyers from communities of color.

These efforts help empowering new homebuyers and underscore our belief that quality homebuyer education is the foundation of successful homeownership and is key to stabilizing Minnesota's neighborhoods. A recent study conducted by Neil Mayer & Associates and the credit bureau Experian found that homeowners that receive pre-purchase education and counseling services are 30% less likely to become seriously delinquent on their mortgage in the first two years after closing.

As part of the press conference announcing the free homebuyer education, Commissioner Tingerthal emphasized that "The best way to prevent future foreclosures is to arm homebuyers with the information necessary to make the right choices about the homebuying process by taking an in-person workshop like Home Stretch or online through Framework," said Minnesota Housing Commissioner Mary Tingerthal. State Director of USDA Rural Development Colleen Landkamer added, "Access to quality, non-biased information about the home buying process, including information about the pitfalls and expenses involved, is key to successful long-term homeownership."
