### The Idea

For the 14<sup>th</sup> consecutive year, NIFA hosted its annual Housing Innovation Marketplace conference bringing together lenders, developers, real estate professionals, non-profit organizations, and city\community leaders for educational sessions and networking opportunities.

The 2016 conference theme was **Hometown Nebraska**: **Celebrate Success** – **Embrace Opportunities**. Our marketing strategy incorporated the views of conference attendees by allowing them to participate through our social media sources both before and during the conference. Using social media as a tool to communicate with attendees was a fun and interactive way to promote the conference and gather stories about hometowns across Nebraska. To build upon the theme and capitalize on familiarity from past attendees, we incorporated last year's conference giveaway item (a blue stress doll) and encouraged attendees to take "selfie" pictures in their communities. These pictures were released through our Facebook and Twitter pages to generate excitement, provide exposure for the conference theme and boost participation. To continue the marketing momentum, we used the pictures with a BINGO card game which ultimately helped to highlight and provide interest surrounding the exhibitors at the conference.

Offering a discounted registration fee also helped spark pre-conference selfie submissions by attendees. Participants who posted a picture that highlighted a success, opportunity or project in their hometown on either Facebook or Twitter using the phrase #hometownNEselfie received a \$25 discount.

Promotion of the conference was entirely paperless through email postcards and social media. During the conference, NIFA provided a video booth where conference attendees could share stories about their hometowns. Special conference t-shirts

with the **Hometown Nebraska** theme were used as an additional promotional item at the conference and NIFA staff wore these t-shirts during the conference making them easily identifiable to conference attendees.

### The Hometown Nebraska Conference

**Hometown Nebraska** was held on March 22-23, 2016 at the La Vista – Omaha Conference Center. The conference kicked off with the "Get to Know Your Exhibitors" breakfast where attendees could visit with our exhibitors and were welcomed by La Vista Mayor Douglas Kindig. For the remainder of the morning, attendees could choose from five different "tracks" of break-out sessions.

NIFA continuously strives to build upon its prior conference experiences and provide added value to conference attendees. This year, NIFA offered a new "track" of sessions focused on Home Builder topics. Additionally, for the second year, at least one session within each track focused on topics particularly relevant to the Native American population.

During lunch, NIFA presented the Housing Champion award and attendees were energized by an overwhelming amount of laughter during Colette Carlson's motivational keynote address: Stress Less, More Success! The afternoon continued with break-out sessions and concluded with a Networking Reception, complete with Nebraska **hometown** live entertainment from John "Honeyboy" Turner singing the Blues.

Day two of the conference began with the "Sponsor Recognition Breakfast" and continued with more break-out sessions. The conference wrapped up with an awards luncheon at which several individuals were inducted into NIFA's "Housing Hall of Fame." Awards were also presented for "Top Producing Lenders," "Top Producing Real Estate Agents," "Property Manager of the Year," and for the "Making a Difference" partner collaboration award.

### The Hometown Materials

NIFA used various materials and mediums in our marketing and promotional efforts for **Hometown Nebraska**. Themed postcards and flyers were distributed via email and posted on NIFA's website, Facebook, and Twitter.

Exhibitors were able to interact with attendees at the opening breakfast and by participating in the BINGO card "selfie trivia" game. Selfies from around Nebraska were assigned to each exhibitor at the conference. The selfies contained a description of the place or community. Attendees were challenged to match the place/community name on the BINGO card with the selfies on display at the exhibitor booths. Attendees with stamps collected from all exhibitors on the BINGO card were eligible to win one of the following prizes: an Amazon Fire TV, a Quadcopter Drone, an Amazon Echo speaker, or a Fitbit HR Wireless Activity Tracker.

A slideshow showcasing the compilation of all of the **#hometownNEselfie** pictures depicting successes, opportunities or projects in hometowns across Nebraska was shown during all general sessions and meals, as well as used in the conference materials and signage.

Attendees could visit the video booth at the conference to express what they love about their hometowns. The videos collected at the conference will be compiled with other videos made in Nebraska hometowns throughout this year as part of a special video project for 2017.

"Giveaways" at the conference included a **Hometown Nebraska** character stress doll magnetized to hold paperclips and a flash drive containing the 2016 Nebraska Profile—an annual report commissioned by NIFA that includes demographic, economic, and housing information for the state. To incentivize video booth participation, the **Hometown Nebraska** t-shirts printed with the conference theme were given to attendees making videos. Samples of the materials can be found in the attached exhibits.

### The Results

The **Hometown Nebraska** conference had 449 registered attendees from 44 individual Nebraska communities and 19 different states. Twenty six exhibitors attended and a record number of 18 sponsorships were obtained, contributing a total of \$43,050. Continuing Education credits were provided to real estate professionals, attorneys, accountants and social work professionals.

Based on the results of an online evaluation survey completed by 109 attendees subsequent to the conference, **Hometown Nebraska** had an overall average rating of 4.6 out of 5. The conference theme was such a success that NIFA will carry it over to the 2017 conference, which coincides with Nebraska's 150<sup>th</sup> birthday. As mentioned above, throughout the year NIFA will be combining videos and pictures highlighting the great communities across the state with the videos gathered at the **Hometown Nebraska** conference to be released in time for the 2017 conference held in conjunction with Nebraska's sesquicentennial.

NIFA's **Hometown Nebraska** conference can be easily replicated by other Housing Finance Agencies. The **Hometown Nebraska** theme and overall encouragement of others to share what makes their hometown a great place to live fostered an energetic and interactive environment creating a successful and vibrant conference. We hope others are inspired to think about their **hometowns**!
