

Engage and Inform Users



Most people are resistant to change, especially changes in technology. It is important to engage users when assessing new technology solutions.

Inform systems users that new tech solutions are being evaluated for use at your organization, and that their input will be requested.



Define and inform users of the desired outcomes to be achieved through the adoption of a new technology/system.





Assessment of Tech Needs

- Identify all systems currently being utilized. (don't assume, ask)
- What are the shortcomings of the systems currently being used?
- Who are the users of these systems? (HFA only or HFA and O/As?)
- What are the data export capabilities of the existing systems?
- Examine workflow to identify areas of duplicitous data entry and areas where improvement is needed.

Assessment of Risks



Engage users to identify risks in order to perform effective change management.



New systems are often disruptive at first, and require users to modify familiar and comfortable working patterns and practices.



Prepare users and leadership for the notion that until all parties gain a comfort level with the new system, the full value may not be realized










