- DC Open Doors is the agency's flagship homebuyers' program (\$561 million in closing and/or downpayment assistance)
- Private cocktail party for homeowners, staff, lenders and realtors (near 100 guests)

- Mobilize and tap resources quickly
- Hire an event planner (provided additional staff, vendor relationships, media relations)
- Meet regularly with the internal teams that can assist you and include the event planner
- Hire an event planner (DCHFA's PR staff is a team of 2.)









