# Contracting Principles 1: Pre-Engagement Information Gathering

# Pre-Engagement Information Gathering

- Identify licensee requirements
- Evaluate/trial the software
- Review software from a business, technical and commercial perspective
- Determine whether software provides functionality/features that meet needs of end users
- Determine mission criticality of software
- How licensing fees are calculated
- Exit strategy if software does not meet needs

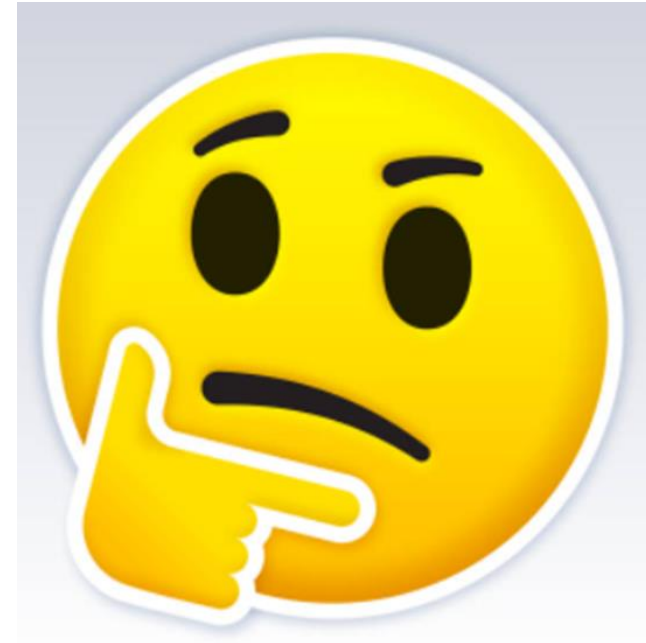
# Working Across Departments
