

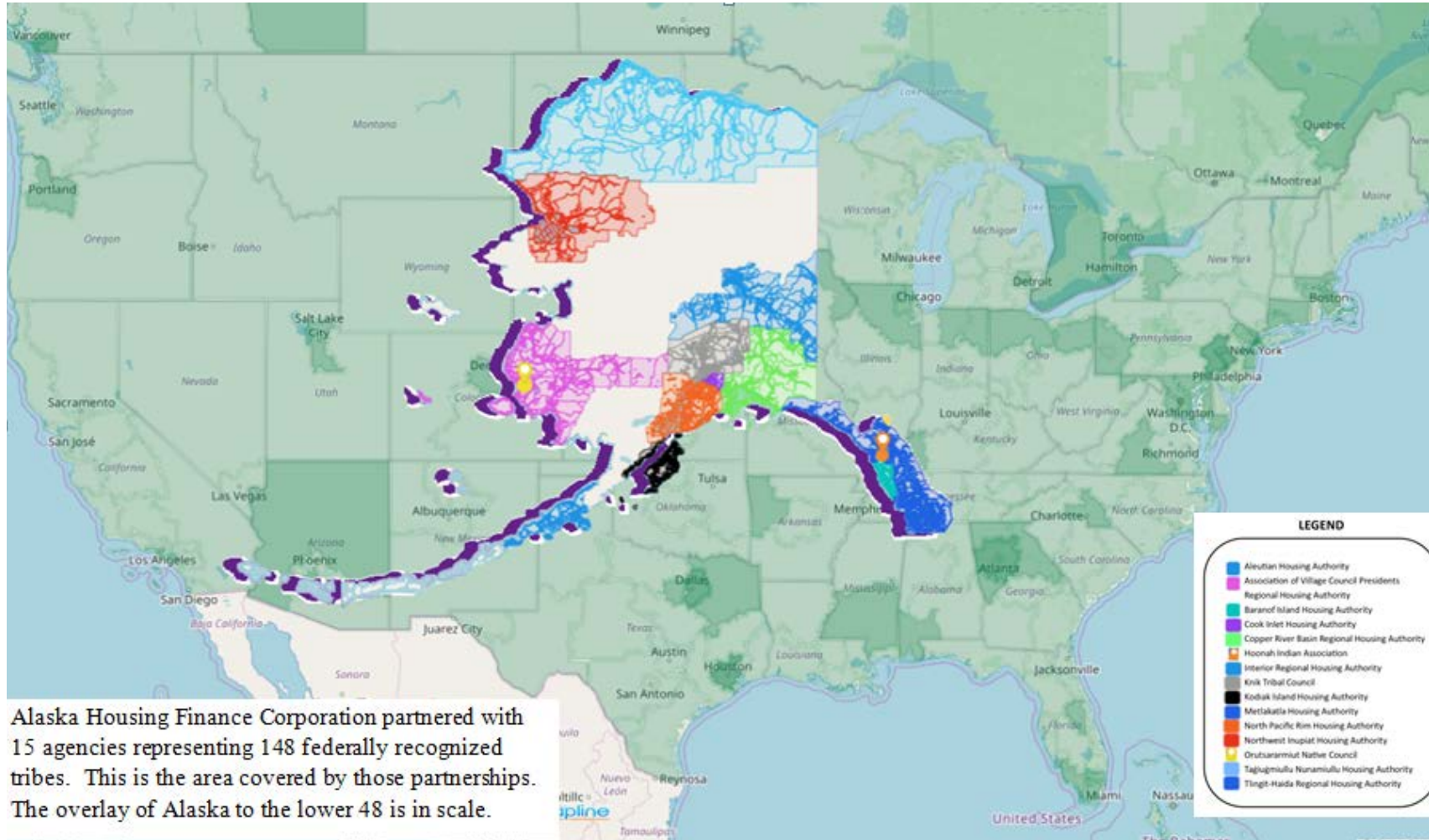


Leveraged Statewide Resources

- If surplus partner funds remain, their program investment can easily be reset

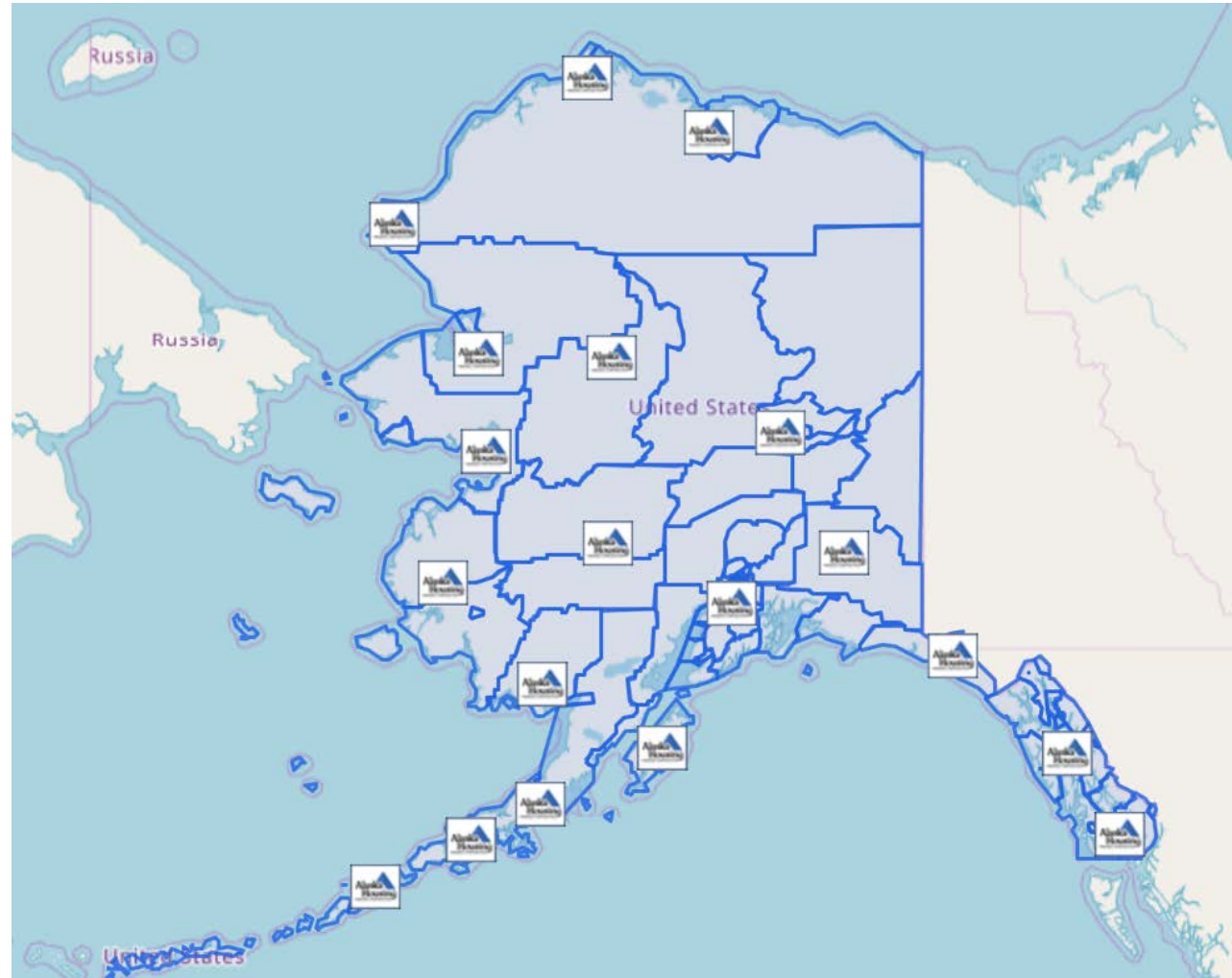
Outcome: \$42M in partner funding secured through 16 entities.

Coverage Area: Our *Small State* Partnership

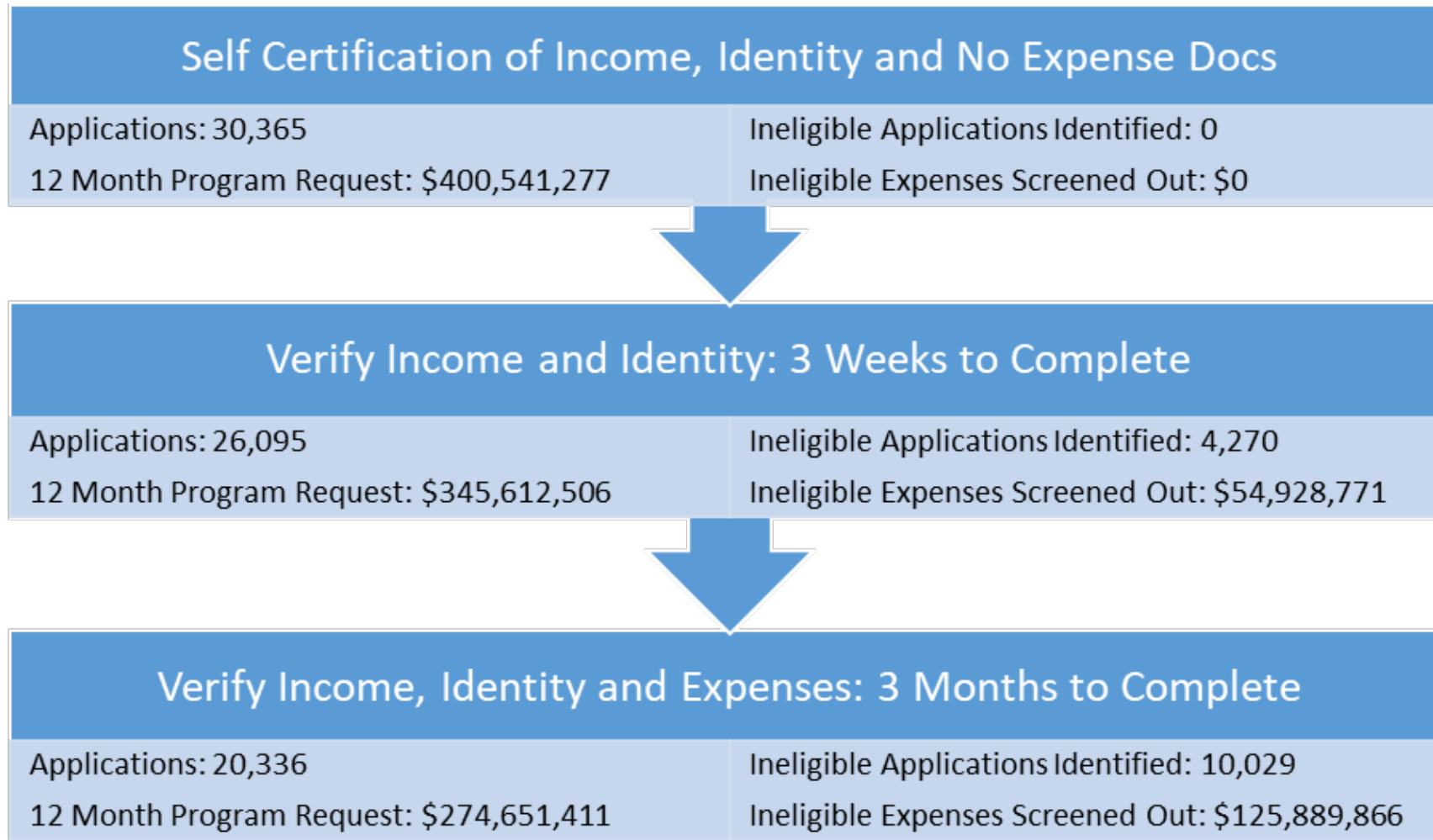

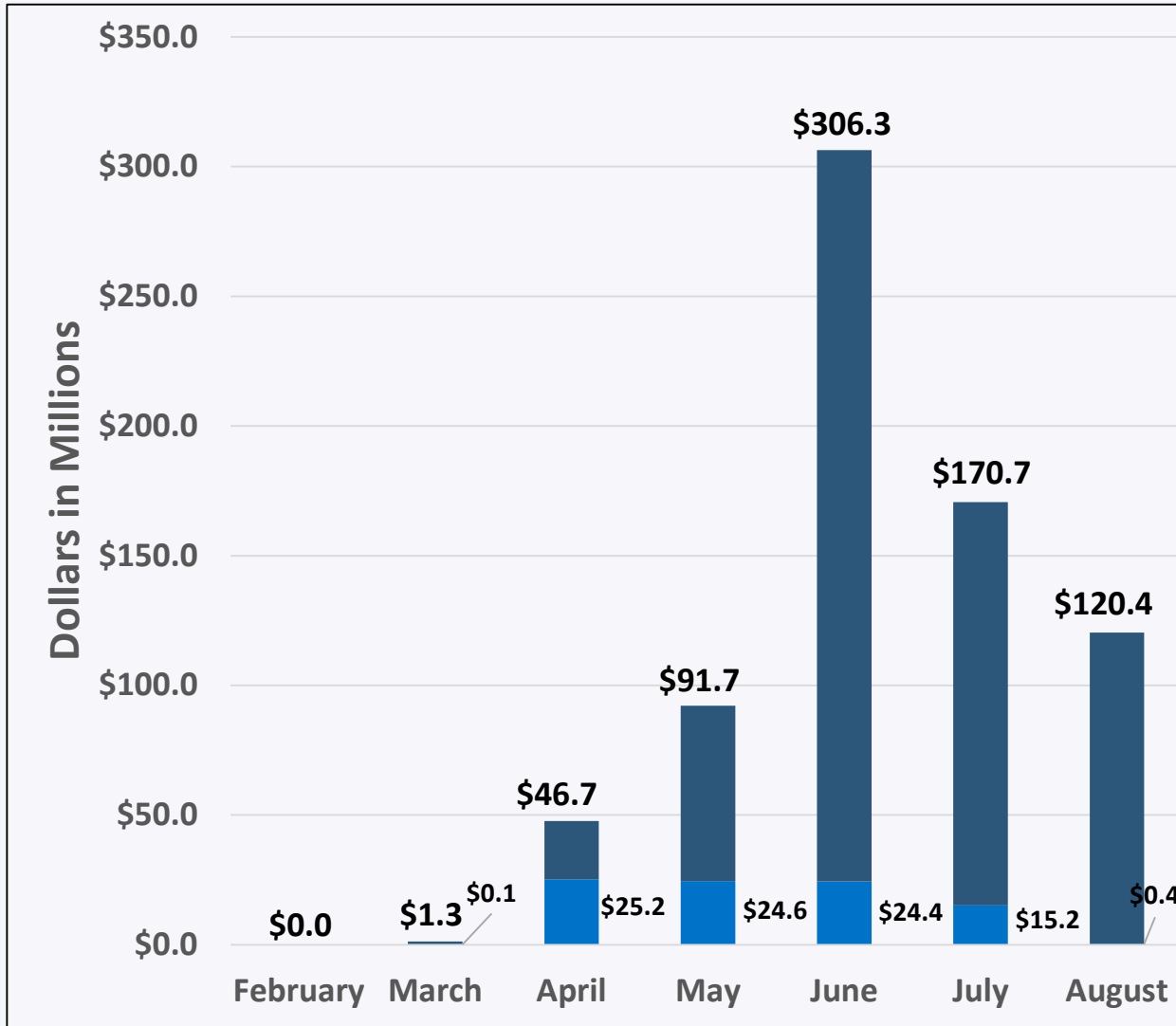

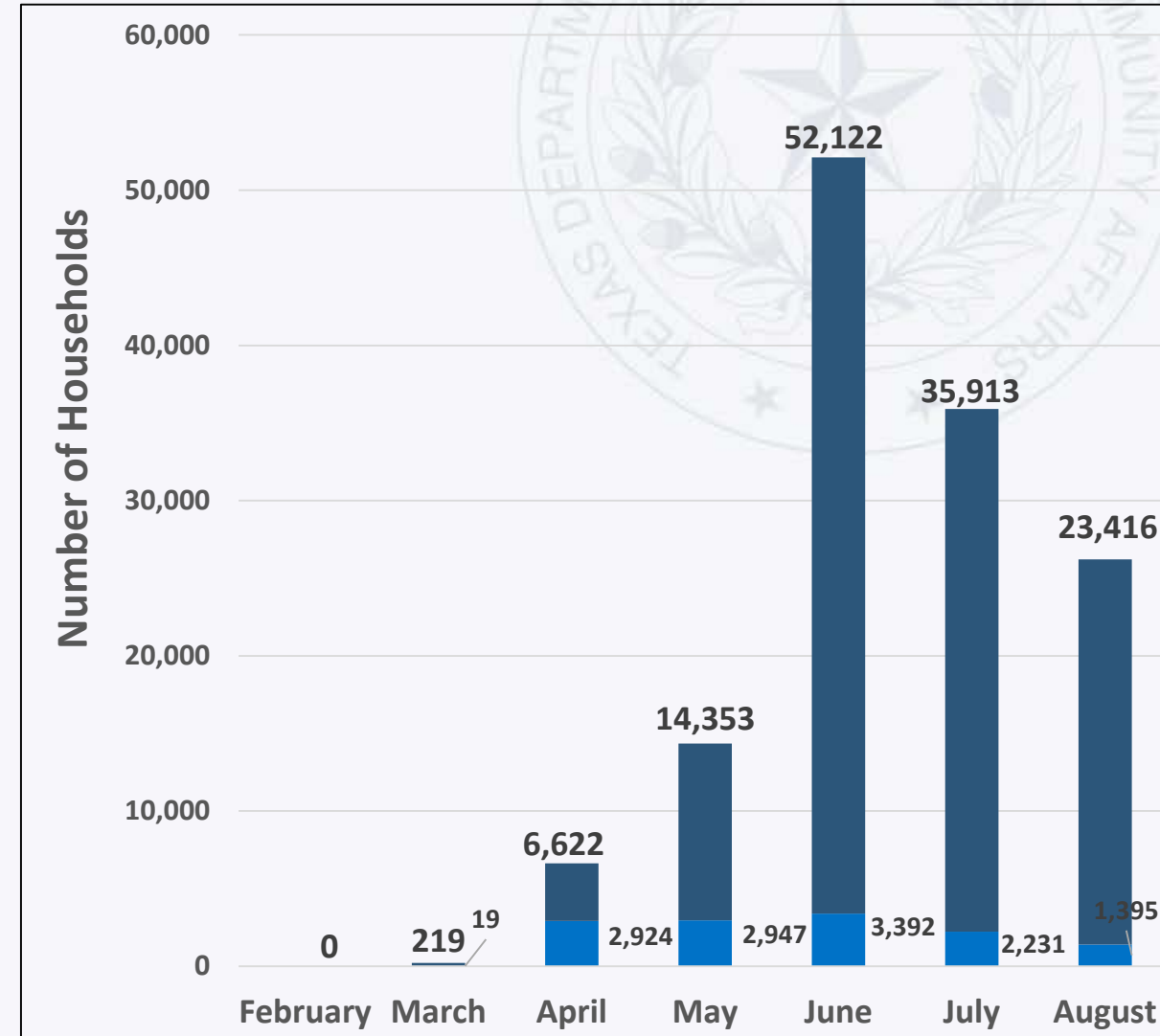
