# **Responding to an Important State Housing Need**

Florida's warm weather, beautiful beaches, and lack of state income tax make it a popular destination for individuals and businesses looking to relocate. In recent years, the state's population has been growing rapidly, putting tremendous pressure on the housing market. Businesses moving here want and need housing for their employees. These factors, while positive for the state, have made the dream of homeownership very challenging for some of Florida's most essential workers.

Law enforcement officers, teachers, nurses, active-duty military, firefighters and other front-line workers were unable to purchase a home or were commuting long hours to and from work because of the shortage of affordable housing options.

Many of these individuals, while critical to Florida's economy, were unable to qualify for existing Florida Housing Finance Corporation homeownership programs due to a higher annual income, yet were still not making enough to afford purchasing a home in Florida.

This led to a statewide need across Florida's communities to help hardworking individuals and essential workers achieve the dream of homeownership so they could live and work in the communities they love.

# Florida Housing's Innovative Solution

In June 2022, Florida Housing launched the Florida Hometown Heroes Housing Program. Recognizing that the lump sum of money necessary for down payment and closing costs is often the largest barrier to homeownership for families, the Hometown Heroes program works to bridge that financial gap by offering up to \$25,000 in down payment and closing cost assistance in the form of a non-amortizing, zero-interest loan. Florida residents who earn less than 150% area median income (AMI) for their county and work in one of more than 100 eligible occupations may qualify for this program.

# **Effective Use of Resources**

The Hometown Heroes program was funded through a \$100 million allocation from the state Legislature. The program was established out of necessity to assist individuals who did not qualify for other state homeownership programs but were still unable to afford to purchase a home. The 150% AMI limitation ensures that funds are going to hardworking individuals and families truly in need of assistance. As an added benefit, since this is a revolving program, whenever one of these individuals sells, rents, or refinances a home that was purchased with Hometown Heroes funds, the loan will be repaid and the funds replenished to assist another essential worker.

# **Effectively Employing Partnerships**

Florida Housing's Single Family Program staff continually offer training courses to lenders and realtors throughout the state.

# Realtors:

We provide a 3-hour online course to realtors that is approved by the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation and counts toward the Realtor continuing education requirements. This course is coordinated through local realtor boards throughout the state. Realtors who attend these classes receive a general three-hour CE credit while learning about our Homebuyer Loan Programs, including Hometown Heroes. Florida Housing has permanent approval from DBPR to offer the class via webinar (online) format. We have found this format to be highly effective in attracting more realtors to the classes while eliminating travel costs entirely.

In 2022, Florida Housing conducted 63 online classes for 34 Board of Realtors Associations located throughout the State of Florida. These classes were attended by approximately 3,326 realtors. Additionally, we conducted 17 Hometown Heroes Product trainings, which were attended by 2,887 realtors.

# Lenders:

Florida Housing periodically conducts telephonic and webinar trainings for lender partners throughout the state. Lender trainings generally consist of program requirements and recent updates, system training with our compliance administrator (eHousingPlus) and first mortgage and servicer requirements and updates with our master servicer, Lakeview.

Together, Florida Housing, eHousingPlus and Lakeview will provide lenders with information to better assist with the origination, delivery and purchase of first and second mortgages originated through our Homebuyer Loan Program.

In 2022, Florida Housing conducted 39 Live Webinars and multiple On-Demand (available daily) Lender trainings. This resulted in more than 16,000 loan officers and their support staff receiving training just this year, which contributed to the record-breaking program production.

# **External Outreach:**

While ensuring that lenders and realtors are trained to help their clients is a critical step, our team also decided it was important to provide information about the program directly to potential homebuyers. Florida Housing partnered with government agencies, statewide associations, and other organizations whose members may be eligible for the Hometown Heroes program. In total, Florida Housing partnered with more than 65 organizations throughout the state for this outreach.

Our External Affairs Team created a marketing toolkit, which included information on how to qualify for the program, a flyer, social media graphics, sample social media posts and eblasts. This tactic provided each entity with tools to easily share information about the program and was also effective in ensuring that any information shared about the program was consistent and in line with Florida Housing's messaging. We also created a dedicated flyer for lenders and realtors to add their contact information for direct distribution to potential clients. These flyers were available in both English and Spanish.

# **Replicable Results**

Since the program's launch less than a year ago, more than \$86 million has been provided to 5,861 frontline workers throughout the state (as of May 5, 2023). The top occupations currently utilizing this program are veterans, nurses, teachers, active-duty military, and law enforcement

officers. All critical occupations that would not have been able to afford to continue living and working in Florida's communities without the Hometown Heroes program.

After seeing the results of this program, and the speed at which the assistance was used by frontline workers, Florida's Legislature codified the Hometown Heroes Program in statute and appropriated an additional \$100 million for the next fiscal year, ensuring it will continue to be funded in the future.

By providing more hardworking Floridians with a place to call home, Florida Housing is proud to help facilitate healthier family environments, build stronger communities, and increase local economic impact. Even better, as individuals begin receiving financial assistance through the Hometown Heroes program, they will be vacating rental units throughout the state, opening them up for others in need.

#### 1. Background on the Program:

The Florida Hometown Heroes Housing Program makes homeownership affordable for eligible frontline community workers such as police officers, firefighters, nurses, childcare workers, and active military or veterans. This program provides down payment and closing cost assistance to income-qualified homebuyers so they can purchase a primary residence in the community in which they work and serve. The Florida Hometown Heroes Loan Program also offers a lower first mortgage rate AND additional special benefits to those who have served and continue to serve their country.

- Eligible borrowers can receive up to 5% of their total loan amount (maximum of \$25,000) in down payment and closing cost assistance.
- Down payment and closing cost assistance is available in the form of a 0%, nonamortizing, 30-year deferred second mortgage. This second mortgage becomes due and payable, in full, upon sale of the property, refinancing of the first mortgage, transfer of deed or if the homeowner no longer occupies the property as his/her primary residence.
- To qualify for this program individuals must provide their certification for one of the eligible occupations and may not be above the program specific income threshold for their county.
