OVERVIEW

Koa'e Makana was developed to provide muchneeded affordable housing for the resort workforce of Poipu, Kauai. 134 LEED-certified affordable units were developed on Kauai

County-owned land with a long-term lease that ensures the project will remain affordable for the longest term possible. The buildings were designed in contemporary plantation style to reflect Koloa Town's history.

The project was awarded the largest amount of 9 percent Low Income Housing Tax Credits in the State of Hawaii at the time and was also the state's first completed Housing



Trust Fund project. The Building Industry Association of Hawaii recognized it with the 2020 Grand Award for Best Affordable Multi-Family Development in Hawaii.
