OVERVIEW

The Nicky Hayden Memorial Apartments addressed a pressing need in the Owensboro community: Offering 12 units of affordable, permanent housing for those transitioning out of homelessness, the apartments are the next step for people graduating from the Daniel PitinoShelter.



The Pitino Shelter assists people experiencing homelessness with many empowerment services, including workforce development, emergency shelter and supportive housing, food, furnishings, and connections to job training, healthcare, transportation, and insurance. The Pitino Shelter is the sponsor and owner of the project and places residents in the units.
