HOME Project Profile Massachusetts | Village at Nauset Green

OVERVIEW

The Village at Nauset Green is a 65-unit multi-family development with 50 affordable units (below 60 percent of area median income), including 11 for extremely low-income households, plus 15 workforce units serving residents earning up to 100 percent of AMI. The project's design aims to evoke the local Cape Cod style and create

a small-village feel for residents, with buildings clustered around two common green spaces. The objective of the development is to help alleviate the demand for quality, affordable housing on Cape Cod, a longtime summer tourist destination where the housing market is significantly impacted by seasonal renters and homeowners.





Multiple towns contributed Community Preservation Act funds to the development, providing a creative, collaborative approach to addressing the need for affordable housing across the Cape. The project more than doubled the number of affordable rental units in the Town of Eastham.
