New Hampshire | Penacook Landing Phase I

OVERVIEW

The Penacook Landing Project, the first of two phases, has 34 newly constructed general occupancy units. The project provides housing for mixed-income families



and onsite education and support, such as financial skills programs and assistance in connecting to other necessary services. The project is located on a bus line that services the City of Concord, providing access to jobs and other amenities not found in the village.

New Hampshire Housing Finance Authority was a key partner, providing capital subsidy of HOME Investment Partnerships and Housing Trust Fund deferred payment loans and a permanent loan to support the long-term financial feasibility of the project. The City of Concord made improvements to the site with Community Block Development Grant funds from the Community Development Finance Authority, before selling a portion of the site to the Caleb Penacook LP. The Genesis Community Loan Fund made its first loan in New Hampshire for acquisition of the property.
