Introduction

In December 2020, the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021 (P.L. 116–260) was passed by the U.S. Congress and signed into law. This legislation included a line-item for states, counties, cities and territories to create an Emergency Rental Assistance Program to help renters and housing providers impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Illinois was set to receive over \$834 million in assistance to be divided by units of local government (ULGs) with over 200,000 residents, or 12 separate units of local government including the state based on population.

As we had to do in 2020, the Illinois Housing Development Authority (IHDA) had to quickly develop a comprehensive marketing campaign to reach Illinois' most vulnerable households. However, this time, IHDA would have to design not only a statewide initiative, but also for four counties that agreed to partner with us on this massive endeavor.

The More the Merrier

Beginning in early January 2021, Illinois Housing Development Authority (IHDA) Executive Director Kristin Faust tasked staff with reaching out to the 11 other ULGs to gauge interest in partnering with IHDA in administering the Illinois Rental Payment Program (ILRPP). ED Faust was well-positioned to pitch partnership to these counties as IHDA successfully designed & executed the successful 2020 Emergency Rental Assistance program, which ultimately provided more than \$230 million in aid to over 46,100 renters and landlords throughout Illinois. In fact, it was one of the largest emergency housing assistance programs launched in response to COVID-19 and IHDA had never previously administered a rental assistance program, so IHDA was a proven commodity.

Director Faust led several meetings with the ULGs to pitch an ILRPP partnership, in large part touting the expertise of IHDA's seasoned Communications Department and our ability to co-market the program specifically to their county constituents. Director Faust championed IHDA and said working together in this endeavor would prove both more efficient and impactful to their residents as opposed to "going it alone." In the end, four counties -- DuPage, Kane, St. Clair and Will Counties -- opted to partner with IHDA in administering this tranche of rental assistance.

Planning & Execution

In early March 2021, IHDA Communications and External Relations staff began meeting weekly with key points of contact within the four county partners to begin discussing how to make ILRPP most effective for their constituents and how to meet their needs.

Per the Intergovernmental Agreement, the parameters established stipulated:

- Agree to fund all approved applications from partner counties;
- Agree to work with County to ensure strong marketing outreach;
- Agree to prepare timely reports for County to deliver to U.S. Treasury;
- Agree to charge 8% administrative fee - less than the 10% allowed; and
- Agree to convene in July to assess demand and determine reallocation of funds if funds cannot be fully obligated.

Critical to this partnership was the marketing & outreach component. Together, county leaders and IHDA determined IHDA would co-brand with each individual county to give their marketing material a personalized touch – and to legitimize that this assistance was coming from both the state and county (which, as evidenced by the Hardest Hit Fund program, tends to help boost applications).

Each county had specific needs that they wanted addressed on the marketing materials and FAQs created for their residents, including additional languages. As they were our partners, IHDA kept pace with each request and quickly amended each piece to suit their needs. In addition, IHDA used color branding unique to each county, as well as the local Area Median Income requirements to tailor each piece specific to the individual county.

Each partner received a co-branded Outreach Kit to ensure they had what they needed to amplify the program. In addition, each county received printed materials to distribute throughout their communities to help educate renters and landlords of ILRPP.

In addition to materials that were for statewide audience, all ILRPP county partners received the following collateral tailored to their branding requirements:

- Flyer
- Tri-Fold Brochure
- Postcard
- Social Media Post Templates

In addition, IHDA coordinated with the counties to provide specific outreach and training through ILRPP webinars, trainings, county board presentations, legislator outreach and other methods. Extra attention was given to these counties in the form of outreach to ensure there was as much awareness as able regarding ILRPP.

As shown in the charts above, IHDA’s partnership with the four counties has shown a tremendous return on investment for them. They also currently make up **four of the six largest counties with completed applications.**

In short, every partner county either nearly matched or exceeded what they allocated to IHDA. Partnering with IHDA meant these counties did not have to spend time or money to design and implement their own program, ensuring more funds are going to help the renters and landlords in their jurisdictions. In short, partnering with IHDA on ILRPP has paid dividends in the form of additional assistance for their residents as they recover and regain financial stability due to COVID-19.

The success of this partnership led to two additional counties (Madison and Lake) who sought to partner for the second round of ILRPP funded through the ERA2 program established by section 3201 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (P.L. 117-2).

WHAT ILRPP OFFERS

The Illinois Rental Payment Program (ILRPP) is an assistance program offered to all eligible Illinois renters impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Tenants whose application is approved will receive a one-time grant of up to \$25,000 paid directly to their landlord to cover missed rent payments between June 2020 and prepay payments through August 2021, or until the grant is exhausted, whichever comes first. Both housing providers and tenants participate in the joint application process.

ILRPP is funded by the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021 and is designed to help tens of thousands of Illinois renters avoid eviction and stay safe and in place during a public health crisis. Please note: an application is not a guarantee of assistance.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To receive assistance through ILRPP, tenants must meet the following criteria:

- Household must have experienced a financial hardship directly — or indirectly — due to the pandemic.
- The household is behind on rent and/ or is at risk of experiencing homelessness or housing instability.
- 2020 household income was below 80% of the Area Median Income (AMI), adjusted for family size.

Illinois Rental Payment Program

The Illinois Rental Payment Program (ILRPP) can provide up to \$25,000 in emergency rental assistance.



Eligibility Requirements

- Household must have experienced a financial hardship directly — or indirectly — due to the pandemic.
- Household is behind on rent and/ or is at risk of experiencing homelessness or housing instability.
- 2020 household income was below 80% of the Area Median Income, adjusted for household size.

Rental Payment Program

- Eligible households may receive up to 15 months of assistance from June 2020 through August 2021.

- The grant is paid directly to housing provider.
